1. I have found no detailed documentation on typical symbology (bubbles, titles, north arrows graphic scales). These items should be addressed extensively in the CADD manual! These items should be available for download.

Response: Symbology is covered in Chapter 6 and Appendix E of the standards. Bubbles, north arrows and graphic scales are included in the General Symbology section of Appendix E. These items will be available for downloading when Release 1.7 of the standards is distributed.

2. The Microstation Levels are not Mapped to the AIA layers in the Matrix Tables. This should be completed to eliminate confusion. Prototype files & Seed files should be available for download!

Response: The final version of Release 1.7 will include MicroStation level numbers assigned to level/layer names. A MicroStation workspace will be provided to assist in implementing the standards.

3. Autocad R14 & Microstation SE should be referred to in the manual in addition to Autocad R13 & Microstation 95!

Response: During the development of Release 1.7, AutoCAD R13 and MicroStation 95 were the current CAD applications available. The next release will address the capabilities of Autodesk and Bentley's CADD software at that time.

Question on implementation

1. When will the Tri-Service CADD standards actually go into effect?

Response: When Release 1.7 is distributed, the Center will request that each service mandate the use of these standards throughout their offices.
