



ENTERPRISE

ENTERPRISE is used whenever a naming convention, hierarchy level, or hierarchy system is required to be used by everyone in U.S. Army Corps of Engineers.



***Enterprise* consists of several components:**

- ▶ Equipment
- ▶ Operating Locations & Location Systems





ENTERPRISE

Equipment

‘Equipment’ is MAXIMO terminology that includes everything that must be maintained such as facilities, large and small ‘pieces’ of equipment, buildings, grounds, river banks, dikes, revetments, roofs and walls, lock chambers and navigation channels, etc.

If it’s a noun . . . it’s ‘*equipment*’







Equipment

- ▶ *Asset Classes*
- ▶ *Asset Groups*
 - *Principal Item Groups*
 - ✓ **Principal Items**, ER 37-2-10, Chapter 31, Appendix A
- ▶ In those cases when an *Asset Group* has a '*Sub-Group*', the '*Sub-Group*' will be treated as an *Asset Group*. This is to avoid adding another hierarchy level.





Enterprise *Operating Locations*

- ▶ **Operating Locations that are used by everyone**
 - U.S. Army Corps of Engineers - USACE
 - Divisions, ERDC
 - Regional HQs, Centers, FOAs, labs
 - Districts
 - Project groups
 - Projects, District office elements

Enterprise Operating Location Systems


- ▶ 'Groups' of locations

 - River

 - Navigation

 - Lake / Pool

 - Basin

ENTERPRISE

Enterprise *Operating Location Systems*


- ▶ ‘Parallel’ to Operating Locations
- ▶ System names must be unique
- ▶ Example: ‘*White River*’ is not a unique system name
 - Solution: Identify where the headwaters originate.
 - White River (AR)
 - White River (IL)


